Length: Two months of PGY-III year

of Hawaii Residency Programs (with permission CEO/PD)

Residents may choose to spend two months in research and/or on elective rotations.

Goals, Objectives and Implementation for Research

Residents have an opportunity to spend two months devoted to individual research projects. (*Refer to Resident Research Program for details.*)

Goals, Objectives and Implementation for Electives

Elective rotations outside of Hawaii Residency Program's affiliated medical centers give residents an opportunity to work with well-known and highly respected orthopaedists in their area of interest. Residents often select sites based upon where they would like to do a fellowship. Rotations at a host institution are generally for one month.

All residents must discuss his/her plans with the Program Director. The issue of medical malpractice coverage must be addressed prior to the granting of permission for the rotation. Contact the Program Administrator for further information.
